An advocacy training seminar focusing on topics that junior housing practitioners might encounter from simple adjournments to suspending warrants and setting aside possession orders. The session offers junior practitioners an opportunity to practice their advocacy skills and build up their experience. Each delegate will present one case and defend another in a mock trial setting. The delegates will have limited time to prepare. They will observe others practising their skills and discuss tactics with colleagues and benefit from feedback, tips and strategies from either a district judge or a senior practitioner. The aim of the seminar is to build confidence and generate experience in advocacy for junior housing practitioners.

Practitioners are advised to attend in good time so as to maximise the opportunity to prepare. Although the focus of the seminar is on advocacy and not legal knowledge, attendees are of course welcome to bring any books or notes that they would normally take to court with them.
